

## ANALYZING A BIBLICAL TEXT / (Sermon preparation)

- I. OBSERVATION (Let the Biblical text speak to you: only use the Bible in this step)
  - 1. Read & Write Observations (at least 4 separate times) on the biblical narrative
  - 2. Write factual questions that remain "What is a ...?
  - 3. Complete a narrative analysis (see handout #2 who, where, what, how, etc.)
  - 4. Search biblical info about the text (OT quotation? Map? Same event elsewhere?)

II. **INFORMATION** (You go to the Biblical text with additional study resources)

- 1. Concordance (Was the topic discussed elsewhere in the Bible?)
- 2. Dictionaries, Encyclopedias & Interlinears (Look for key words)
- 3. Social Analysis (see handout #2 customs, background)
- 4. Commentaries from scholars (e.g. NICTO, NICNT, WBC, etc.)

## III. <u>APPLICATION</u>

- 1. Theological themes highlighted in the text
- 2. Relationship of the narrative with the gospel (Christ crucified)
- 3. Application for daily and contemporary life
- 4. Appeal
